Nature of the Work

The role of the Psychologist at Summit School is one of a clinical professional who works with students diagnosed with neurodevelopmental disorders. We provide an integrated and multidisciplinary approach to support our students, teachers, and parents.

Requirements & Qualifications

- Offer consultation and support to parents and school professionals with the goal of developing a better understanding of students' psychological, behavioral, social-emotional, and educational needs.
- Design individualized behavioral programs to facilitate students' classroom integration in collaboration with a multidisciplinary team.
- Conduct psychological assessments and provide meaningful recommendations to inform educational and social programming.
- Provide behavioral strategies and crisis intervention to support students' psychological and emotional well-being during moments of distress and/or challenging behavior.
- Provide intervention to individual students and groups (i.e. individual therapy, conflict resolution, peer mediation, social skills, emotional regulation).
